Staff

The company employs over 450 unskilled labourers on average per year. The skilled taskforce approximates to 150 local employees and 50 expatriates. Indirect employment ranges from 500 to 1000 people.Senior employees of the company all have 10+ years in experience in their respectable departments that range from engineers, accountants, financers and marketers. The human resource department is well equipped to source and allocate to uphold production.

Plant & Equipments

The company has over 30 light duty vehicles, 80 heavy duty vehicles, and 50 plant/equipment distributed between Morogoro and Mwanza. All vehicles and equipment are well maintained via two fully equipped workshops in Morogoro and Mwanza. The company's maintenance crew consists of more than a dozen qualified personnel from all major manufacturers such as Toyota, Nissan, Scania, Iveco, Caterpillar, Komatsu and Dynapac.

Materials & Materials Testing

IASCO

The company supplies and stocks various sizes of crusher run aggregates in Mwanza and Morogoro utilising a 450 TPH and a 200 TPH crusher respectively. Another mobile crusher of 100 TPH is at standby in the Mwanza yard. Asphalt Concrete is also supplied in Mwanza and Morogoro via batch mix and continuous mix respectively. Other supplies include paving blocks, culverts, building blocks, beacons, and various concrete structures. Quality control is unparalleled in these products as the company has two complete material laboratories in Mwanza and Morogoro.
